


EMERGENCY CORRIDOR

















EMERGENCY CORRIDOR can Save Lives!

- MAKE WAY FOR EMERGENCY AND POLICE VEHICLES! -

WHY?

Response teams have to be able to reach an accident scene as quickly as possible in order to

- save lives,
- clear the accident scene and thus
- prevent serious accidents at the tail end of a traffic jam.

WHERE?

On motorways and roads outside built-up areas with at least two lanes for one direction.

WHEN?

Whenever vehicles

- drive at walking speed or
- have come to a standstill (traffic jam)

until traffic flows smoothly again.

HOW?

Between the left lane and the right lane directly next to it.





WHAT IF NOT?

Traffic offence	Standard fine	Penalty points	Driving licence suspension
Failure to form an emergency corridor	200€	2	1 month
- with obstruction	240 €	2	1 month
- with endangerment	280€	2	1 month
- with property damage	320 €	2	1 month
